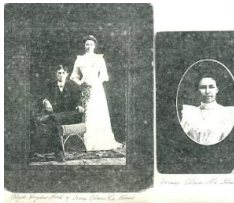
The Muskogean Area Director has forwarded for determination your request of the degree of Citizen Potawatomis blood you have in you as the membership roll of the Citizen Band of Potawatomis Indians.

According to the information submitted with your request, you are listed on the Citizen Potawatomis membership roll as a member 1/2 Muskogean Potawatomis blood. The record, however, that you were not credited with Citizen Potawatomis Indian blood derived from your paternal grandfather, Nathan LeClair, and that you possess a lesser degree of Citizen Potawatomis blood than the amount you seek.

The records indicate that your mother, Bertha Agnes, claims to possess Cherokee Indian blood (as does the Service of Indian blood has not been substantiated). Your father, Henry LeClair, as the son of Nathan LeClair and his wife, Sarah LeClair, determined that Thomas A. Mulla, your paternal grandfather, possessed 1/2 degree Citizen Potawatomis blood. The maternal grandfather, in such instances, therefore, would likewise possess 1/2 degree Citizen Potawatomis blood.

On November 3, 1976, the Acting Director, Office of Indian Services, found that Nathan LeClair, who is shown as a Muskogean Potawatomis member, possessed 1/2 degree Citizen Potawatomis blood. Since there is no indication that his father possessed Citizen Potawatomis blood, and any indication you his father was, Nathan LeClair would possess 1/2 degree Citizen Potawatomis blood. Based on the records, you father, your grandfather, would possess 1/2 degree of Citizen Potawatomis blood. If your mother's father is not a Citizen Potawatomis, you would possess 1/2 degree Citizen Potawatomis blood. A family history sheet which outlines our findings is enclosed.
