- WHEREAS: It is expected that we will utilize approximately \$2000.00 for the balance of this fiscal year 1964.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the funds in the amount of \$5,200.00 be rebudgeted for use in fiscal year 1965 as follows:
