A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE CITIZEN BAND POTAWATOMI TRIBE OF OKLAHOMA BE ALLOWED TO CONTINUE PARTICIPATION IN THE TRIBAL GOVERNMENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM IN FISCAL YEAR 1974.

WHEREAS, the Citizen Band Potawatomi Tribe of Oklahoma, a tribe of some 11,000 enrolled members, has a great need to provide full-time care of Tribal affairs, and


WHEREAS, the Citizen Band Potawatomi Tribe of Oklahoma has a very limited income, and


WHEREAS, tribal officers serve without salary and devote only part-time to tribal business,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Citizen Band Potawatomi Tribe of Oklahoma be allowed to continue participation in Tribal Government Development Program for FY-74 and that the attached proposal be included in our FY-74 contract.
