WHEREAS, the preservation of the history and culture of the Citizen Band of Potawatomi Indians of Oklahoma and other Indian people is a great concern and a contribution to the preservation could be made by the Citizen Band of Potawatomi Indians Curriculum Development Project, and,

WHEREAS, this grant would commence on or about April 1, 1978, and continue through March 31, 1979, and,

WHEREAS, Paul E. Schmidlkofer, Tribal Chairman, is the authorized tribal official to negotiate the grant and any amendments thereto, and,

WHEREAS, Paul E. Schmidlkofer, Tribal Chairman, is the authorized tribal official to execute the grant and any amendments, thereto, and,

WHEREAS, the final contract, or amendments thereto will be reviewed and approved by the Business Committee of the Citizen Band of Potawatomi Indians of Oklahoma.
