- WHEREAS, the Citizen Band Potawatomi Indians of Oklahoma is a federally recognized tribe of American Indians under authority granted by the Indian Recognition Act of 1934, and
- WHEREAS, the Citizen Band Potawatomi Indians of Oklahoma is eligible for grant applications under Title VI of the Older American Act, and
- WHEREAS, Linda Coventon, Director of Health Planning, is authorized to coordinate grant development and can be reached at telephone number (405) 275-3121, and
- WHEREAS, Administration on Aging is requested to send copies of all correspondence to John Schoemann, Tribal Administrator, and to Linda Coventon, Director of Health Planning, and
- WHEREAS, these authorities will remain in effect until such time as the Business Committee chooses to withdraw said authorization, and to approve them by resolution, and
- WHEREAS, the Business Committee reserves the right to review the grant document thereto prior to signature by designated persons.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Business Committee of the Citizen Band Potawatomi Indians of Oklahoma wishes to make grant application to the Administration on Aging for Title VI of the Older American Act Funds.
