



- WHEREAS, the Citizen Band Potawatomi Business Committee is duly authorized to act on behalf of the Tribe by authority of the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS, in the tribe's endeavor to promote public activities and functions, it is desirable to enlist the assistance and support of individual tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, to meet some critical needs an appeal was made through various channels; and
- WHEREAS, the response to the tribe was above and beyond the expectation for assistance; NOW

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Business Committee, on behalf of the members of the tribe, conveys it's gratitude and heartfelt thanks to Mr. Bob Davis, for the contribution of the sound equipment and system for the Pow-Wow and General Council.
