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- C. Due to the expense involved in housing, handling, maintaining, insuring and exhibiting collections, loans cannot ordinarily be accepted.
- D. All donations are subject to the approval of the Citizen Potawatomi Business Committee upon recommendation of the Museum's professional staff.

- 1. The material shall be available to any qualified researcher upon approval of the Archivist.
- Literary rights of the donor and heirs to print quotations which embrace either part of the whole of the unpublished material in the gift are transferred to the Citizen Potawatomi Archives.
- The Archives Division has the right to make copies of the material by microfilming, or by other processes which do not infringe upon the copyright laws of the land.
- 4. If, during the accessioning process any portion of the gift is not deemed suitable to the purposes of the Archives Division, it may be disposed of at the discretion of the Archivist, or it may be returned to the donor if so specified in this agreement.
