Ordinance #09-01-R&G-0901-T5

AN ORDINANCE granting to members of the Tribal Legislature, privilege from arrest during legislative sessions.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CITIZEN POTAWATOMI NATION that members of the Tribal Legislature shall be privilege from arrest during legislative sessions and in going to and returning from the same, except for treason, felony or breach of peace; and for any comments, speech or debate in the legislature, which shall not be questioned in any other place.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CITIZEN POTAWATOMI NATION that the Ordinance granting such protection for members of the Legislature **IS HEREBY APPROVED.**

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption by the Legislature of the Citizen Potawatomi Nation.


