

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BUSINESS COMMITTEE OF THE CITIZEN BAND POTAWATOMI INDIAN TRIBE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY. Section 921 of the Civil Procedure Code of the Citizen Band Potawatomi Indian Tribe of Oklahoma is amended to read as follows:


Section 921. In this act, 'foreign judgment' means any judgment, decree, or order of a court of the United States, any Indian tribe, or of any other court that is entitled to comity or full faith and credit in the tribal court. Such comity or full faith and credit shall be granted to a judgment, decree or order of a state court that recognizes the judgments, decrees and orders of this court.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY. Section 922 of the Civil Procedure Code for the Citizen Band Potawatomi Indian Tribe of Oklahoma is amended to read as follows:

Section 922. A properly authenticated copy of any foreign judgment may be filed in the office of the court clerk. The clerk shall treat the foreign judgment in the same manner as a judgment of the tribal district court. A judgment so filed has the same effect and is subject to the same procedures, defenses, and proceedings for reopening, vacating, or staying as a judgment of the tribal district court and may be enforced or satisfied in a like manner.
