

Uniform Commercial Code Ordinance

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BUSINESS COMMITTEE OF THE CITIZEN BAND POTAWATOMI INDIAN TRIBE OF OKLAHOMA:

Section 1: CITATION


This Act may be cited as the Uniform Commercial Code of the Citizen Band Potawatomi Indians of Oklahoma, a federally recognized Tribe of American Indians under authority of the Oklahoma Indian Welfare Act of 1936.


Section 2: PURPOSE


This Act for the Citizen Band Potawatomi Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma is established to provide the Tribe and its subordinate enterprise activities a uniform commercial code for purposes of giving and receiving security instruments in the pursuit of commercial business activity.


CERTIFICATION
