Bernard Heer made a motion that we remove the Whitlock children

to select applicants for the H.I.P. Program priority list for the
Citizen Band Potawatomi applicants. Bernard Heer seconded the
motion and the motion carried with 5 for and none against.

Jerry Fox made a motion that Mary Wheeler be accepted as the new
CHR to PHS Indian Health. Willie Nona seconded the motion and
the motion carried with 5 for and none against.

Beverly Hughes made a motion that Janell Veitenheimer be the CHR
Coordinator for PHS. Bernard Heer seconded the motion and the
motion carried with 5 for and none against.

Jerry Fox made a motion that the committee send a telegram to
LeRoy Neddeau in Kansas to have him attend a meeting that the
Prairie Band and Jesuits were having and to try and stop any
action they may be taking to regain the land at St. Marys Kansas
Bernard Heer seconded the motion and there were 5 for and none
against.

Bernard Heer made a motion that the meeting be adjourned and
Willie Nona seconded the motion The motion passed with 5 for
and none against.
