FIVE TRIBES - SHAWNEE AGENCY - SHAWNEE, OKLAHOMA 4 January 1971

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT JOHN E. TAYLOR BE RETAINED AT THE SHAWNEE AGENCY AS FIELD ADMINISTRATOR.

WHEREAS, an informal meeting, composed of elected tribal officials of the Iowa Tribe, the Sac and Fox Tribe of Oklahoma, the Absentee Shawnee Tribe, the Citizen Band of Pottawatomies, and the Kickapoo Tribe was held 4 January 1971, and

WHEREAS, the above five named Indian Tribes, comprised of the area under the Shawnee Agency, Shawnee, Oklahoma, met to discuss the structure and policy of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, success in the BIA's efforts to increase Indian participation depends upon the responsiveness and initiative of the Field Administrator and his staff, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the representatives in attendance that it be made known to all concerned that they hereby unanimously request that John E. Taylor be retained in his present position as the Field Administrator of the Shawnee Agency.

NOWS, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the elected tribal officials in attendance at an informal meeting of the five tribes of the Shawnes Agency, composed of the Iowa Tribe, the Sac and Fox Tribe of Tklahoma, the Absentee Shawnes Tribe, the Citizen Band of Por awatomies, and the Kickapoo Tribe, do hereby express their falls, trust, and confidence in John E. Taylor, and request that Commissioner Brues retain John E. Taylor as Field Administrator of the Shawnes Agency, at a higher grade than he is now.

PASSED AND APPROVED THIS 4th day of January 1971, by a unanimous vote.
